Структура вступительных испытаний

- ✓ **устный зачет** (монологическое высказывание по картинке и беседа по заданной теме)
- ✓ **грамматическое тестирование**

Устный зачет в виде монологического высказывания предполагает описание картинки - отправной точки высказывания, в рамках которого учащийся должен продемонстрировать уровень владения иностранным языком.

Критерии оценивания монологического высказывания

1. Лексическое наполнение.
2. Владение грамматическими структурами языка.
3. Беглость речи.
4. Логика и последовательность высказывания.

1. Вселенная и человек. Природа.
2. Проблемы экологии. Защита окружающей среды.
3. Мир профессий. Проблемы выбора профессии.
4. Одежда. Молодежная мода. Внешность.
